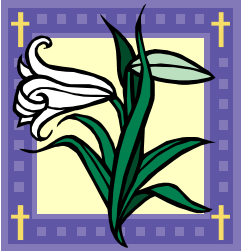

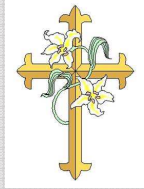
After the worship service and weather permitting, the benediction will take place outside in the Memorial Garden where we will be placing flowers on the Easter cross.

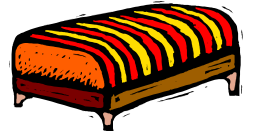
