Last week the children remained in service to witness the first Communion class receive their First Communion. This week the Children will remain in service to help with Youth Sunday.

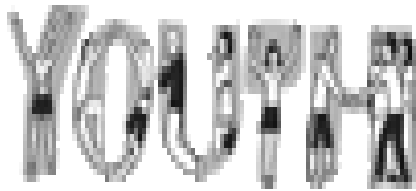
